Previously, Mr. Goettman was a Managing Member at Thayer Capital Partners, a Washington, D.C. based private equity firm with more than \$1.5 billion in equity investments. As a private equity investor, Mr. Goettman has served as the chairman of the board of more than 10 businesses and as a board member on several more. Mr. Goettman specialized in creative and flexible capital structures tailored toward a management philosophy of responsible stewardship, enabling management, and creating enduring businesses.

Prior to his private equity-investing career, Mr. Goettman specialized in mergers and acquisitions as an investment banker with Morgan Stanley, Wasserstein Perella, and Robertson Stephens. Mr. Goettman holds a BS in Economics and Computer Science from Duke University, where he graduated magna cum laude with honors in Economics and enjoyed a four-year varsity golf career.
