SUBJECT: Country Limitation Schedule (CLS)

<u>Cover Policy Changes:</u> A new CLS with the following cover policy changes is effective December 24, 2025:

Guinea: Opened for short-, medium-, and long-term transactions in the public and private sectors.

Kenya: Closed for short- and medium-term transactions in the public sector and remains closed for long-term transactions. Closed for short-, medium-, and long-term transactions in the private sector.

Suriname: Opened for short-term transactions in the private sector.

Tunisia: Opened for medium-term transactions in the public and private sectors.

Egypt: Removed Note # 15b

Guinea: Added Notes #1, 15a, 15b; Removed Note #13

Kenya: Removed Notes # 1, 3, 5, 15b **Suriname:** Added Notes # 1, 11b

Tunisia: Removed Notes # 11a, 11b
